Below are some key aspects of the role as a volunteer that are important to both The Depot and our audience.

Front of house

This involves the meeting and greeting of visitors, ensuring that each one feels welcomed into the Depot environment and is informed of the goings on. This particular aspect of the role is most important to us as volunteers are often the first point of contact at The Depot and we want to ensure that their approach aligns with our values of professionalism and inclusiveness. Sales processing and gallery maintenance are also a part of the front of house responsibilities.

Installation/De-installation of exhibitions

In our three gallery spaces exhibitions are run for three week periods. Turnarounds are a busy time and provide the opportunity for some hands-on work in the gallery.

Computer tasks

Computer skills are particularly useful for various tasks in the gallery and your knowledge of programs such as Word, Excel or the Adobe suite would be of real assistance to us for data management.
